Our next schedule will have instructions about what to do with your instrument over the summer, as well as information about summer lessons, if you are interested in playing over the summer.

## THE CONCERT IS COMING!!!!

Yes, this means concert try-outs. Here's how it works: the whole class plays the piece together while we observe each child. If they have a good grasp of how to play the piece correctly and in tune, they pass the piece. We have three weeks of try-outs, so there are three opportunities to pass the songs. As long as a student passes one song, they will play in the concert. At the end of the three try-outs, if there are any songs they haven't passed, they will stay in rest position during that piece only. There is no advantage to passing all the songs on the first try. Students should not be discouraged, because the majority of them will pass by the third try-out. Try-outs should not be stressful or upsetting, they should serve to help the students be more focused in their practice. *All students who have been attending lessons regularly and practicing conscientiously will play the concert.*
